# MOTH TRACKER

The Critically Endangered Mountain Pygmy-possums are awake from their winter hibernation and hungry for Bogong Moths. But the moths are disappearing, leaving the tiny possums without enough to eat.

You can help them by keeping an eye out for Bogong Moths and recording any sightings on Moth Tracker. This will provide scientists with important information.

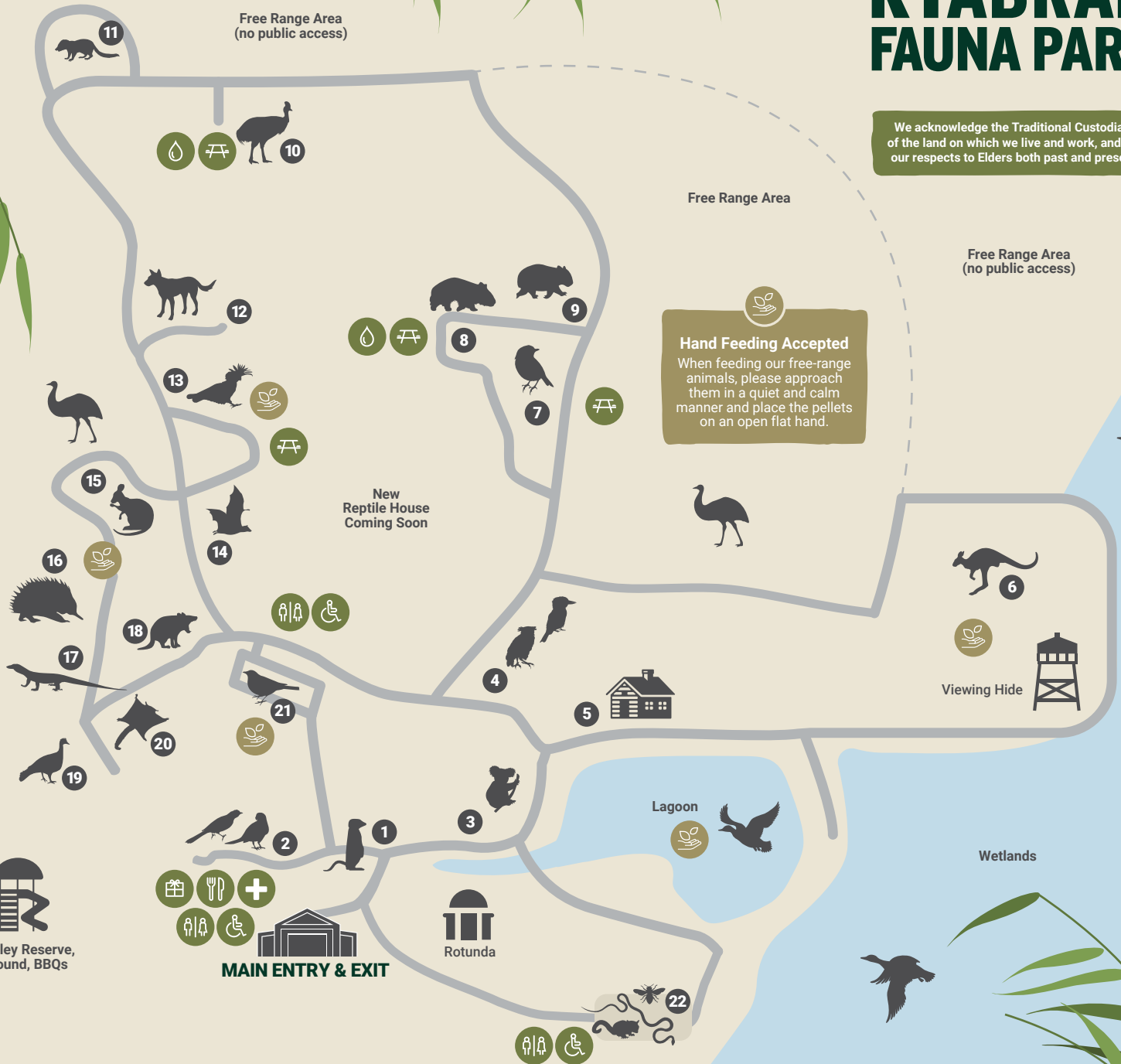
