- Explore the Five Domains Model and other tools used to assess animal welfare, and support evidence-based decision-making.
- Hear first-hand accounts from Zoos Victoria staff who have used the tool to support improved welfare outcomes.
- Learn how to plan for and strive for continuous improvement in welfare assessment.
- Investigate case studies of animal welfare interventions
