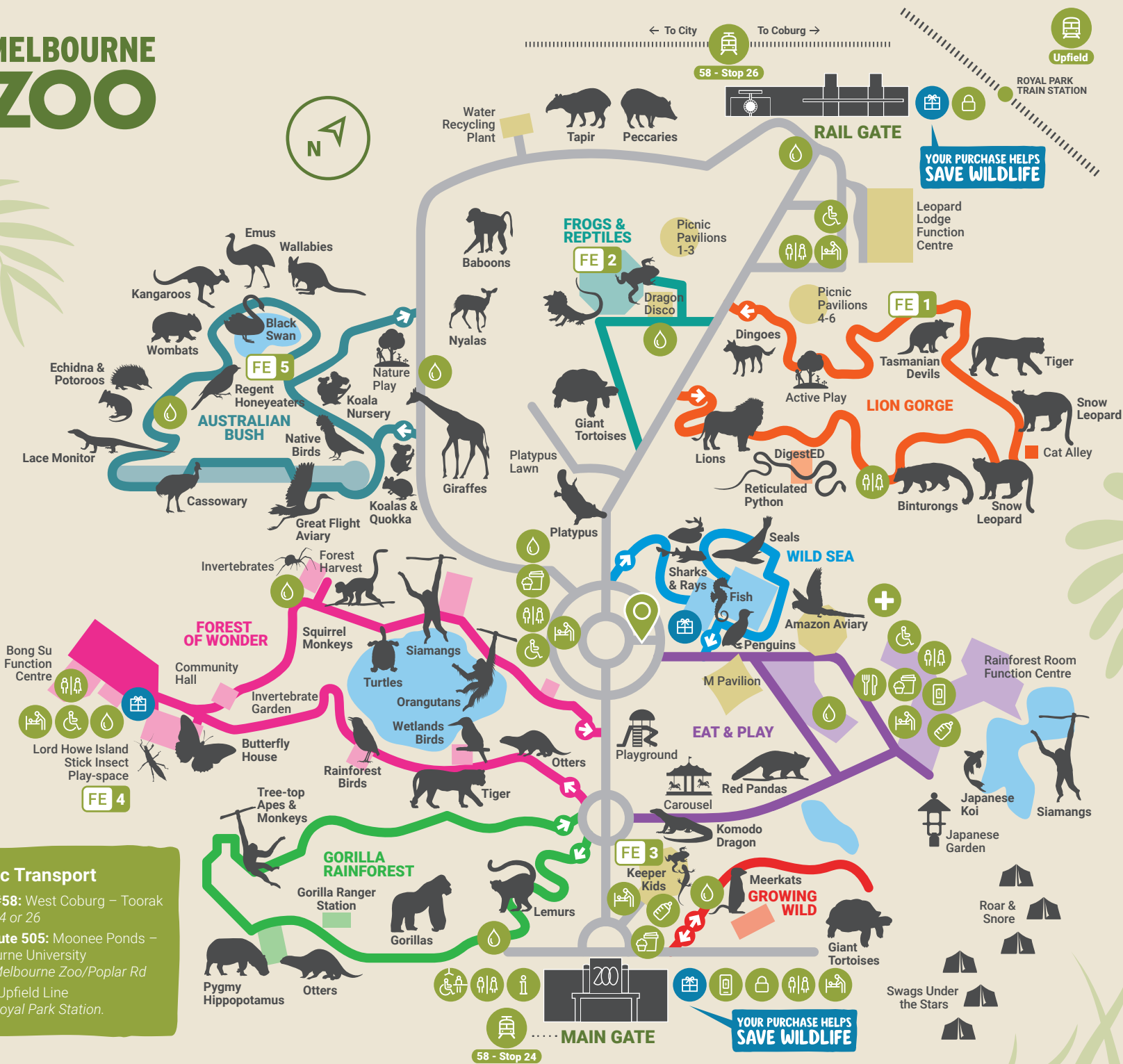


Welcome
